


Bugs—Minibeast story

Venue: Wardown House Museum (45 minutes)

Session summary:

This session allows the children to consider some of the mini creatures that might live around us. The children will then take part in our specially written story about minibeasts and interact with lots of different objects.

To finish the session the children will have the opportunity to colour in a some butterfly wings to take back to school.





Learning objectives:

The pupils will have the opportunity to:

- · Work individually, in small groups and as a whole class.
- · Consider the needs of some of the creatures that may live at Wardown.
- Make some wings to take home.
- · Listen to and participate in a story.

Suggested activities:

After the visit:

- The children could finish their wings and tell their own stories using them.
- They could search their school grounds for creatures that live there and make a record of what they spot.
