
#### **Accessibility:**

# Travelling to The Coach House at Wardown:



#### **Parking**

We have two free car parks on site - one can be accessed via Old Bedford Road and the other via New Bedford Road. During the winter months, we recommend you use New Bedford Road, as the lighting is much better suited for darker conditions.



#### Train

The site is approximately 1 mile from Luton station. It's a lovely walk on a summer's day, but if you'd prefer to travel via cab, a taxi rank is located directly outside Luton station.
